Answers and Explanations

1) **A**

Up is the opposite of *down*. *Left* is the opposite of *right*. Therefore **(A)** is correct.

2) **A**

Eyes are used to *see*. *Fingers* are used to *touch*. Therefore **(A)** is correct.

3) **D**

A characteristic of *summer* is to be *hot*. A characteristic of *winter* is to be *cold*. Therefore **(D)** is correct.

4) **A**

A characteristic of a *banana* is to be *yellow*. A characteristic of a *carrot* is to be *orange*. Therefore **(A)** is correct.

5) **C**

Pork is a type of *meat*. *French* is a type of *language*. Therefore **(C)** is correct.

6) **D**

A *nurse* works at a *hospital*. A *waiter* works at a *restaurant*. Therefore **(D)** is correct.

7) **B**

A *pencil* is used to *write*. A *knife* is used to *cut*. Therefore **(B)** is correct.

8) **A**

Something that is very *good* is *wonderful*. Something that is very *tasty* is *delicious*. Therefore **(A)** is correct.

9) **A**

Someone who is *hungry* needs to *eat*. Someone who is *tired* needs to *sleep*. Therefore **(A)** is correct.

10) **D**

A *bed* can be found in a *bedroom*. A *toilet* can be found in a *bathroom*. Therefore **(D)** is correct.
